

constant luminance colorizer tints



These tints have the magical property that they can take a preexisting gray, show it in color onscreen and yet still print the original gray to a B/W hard copy printer. They are especially well suited to online display of older printed documents.

Install in existing program where `-setgray-` can be redefined, following the routines in COLORIZ2.PS on www.tinaja.com

The `-tint-` variable is a max saturated constant luminescence hue. 0 = red, 0.33 = green 0.67 = blue 1.0 = red. The background shade shown is 0.92 setgray. The lettering is 0.33 setgray,
